Activities at the Arizona Corporation Commission

- **Electric Energy Efficiency Standard Rules** issued on August 10, 2010
- Rules effective January 1, 2011
- Applicable to utilities with more than \$5 million annual revenue
- Required energy savings by 2020:
 - 22% of 2019 energy sales
- Standard starts at 1.25% and ramps up every year
- Cooperatives have 75% of requirement
