2008 Sep – 2010 Sep, construction completed Phase 1

2010 Oct – 2011 May, construction completed Phase 2

2011 May, Fort Collins asks to change 1.6-mile section of Phase 3
in Pineridge Natural Area from overhead to underground*

2011 Sep scheduled to begin construction on Phase 3 (original plan)
