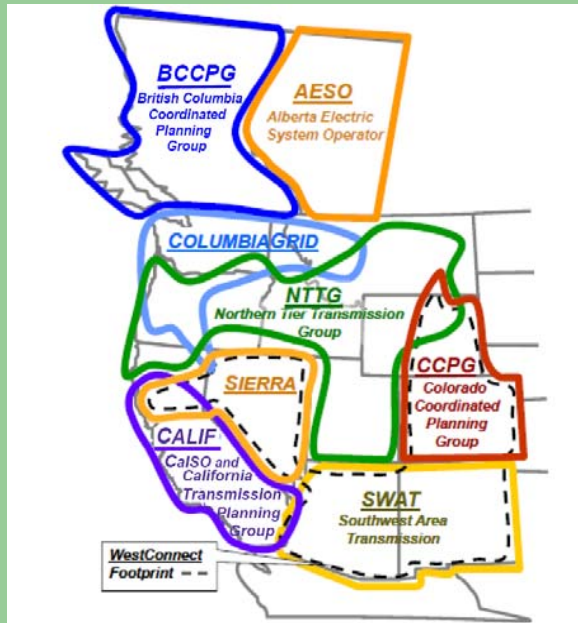

 - November 18, 2011 to January 20, 2012
- WECC 10-year Plan issued September 2011
 - Report ([WECC Study Report](#))
- 2022 Common Case (CC) Informational Webinars
 - Dec 12th – Case development process and modeling assumptions
 - Dec 9th – CC Transmission Assumptions (CCTA)
 - Dec 16 – CC Loads, Energy Efficiency, DSM
 - Jan 6th – CC Resource Assumptions
 - Jan 13th – CC Reserve requirements and cost of cycling
