



The Central Arizona Transmission System-High Voltage (CATS-HV) group has included as a part of their 2009 study plan a task that includes the coordination of the CATS-HV regional transmission plans with the jurisdictional land use and comprehensive plans located within the CATS-HV area. This coordination effort is expected to produce a common GIS based planning map that can be shared with multiple jurisdictions.

In order to accomplish this task the CATS-HV group is hosting a series of workshops to begin the planning process of the GIS database. During the first workshop there were discussions on what type of information to include, who should host the site and who should be involved in the planning process.

The second workshop is going to focus more on the details. There will be several presenters discussing specific projects that they have worked on, or are working on, and how they gather and maintained the GIS information for the project. The presenters will also touch on how the GIS database could be beneficial in future planning. A representative from Pinal County will speak on how the site can be maintained and the different security measures that will be necessary to ensure that the information on the database stays confidential. There will also be representatives from the Arizona State Land department to discuss their ideas for what should be included in the database and how it could benefit the State Land Department.
