The course, lunches and breaks will be in Public Service Company of new Mexico's main building at 414 Silver Ave SW, phone (505) 241-4562, in downtown Albuquerque. The building is easy to reach by car or cab, and parking is easily available.

### **Directions to PNM:**

From Airport: Go toward Airport exit on Sunport Loop SE - go 0.3 mi, Sunport Loop becomes Sunport Blvd SE- go 0.9 mi, take ramp onto I-25 North toward Downtown and Santa Fe - go 0.3 mi, take exit 224 onto Oak St SE toward Central Ave/Lead-Coal Ave – go 0.3 mi, turn L on Lead Ave go 0.7 mi., turn R on 2<sup>nd</sup> St – go 0.1 mi, turn L on Silver Ave– go 0.1 mi., arrive at 414 Silver Ave SW.

#### **1. Guest Parking:**

SW corner of 5th & Lead (behind PNM building). Take Lead Ave west, to 5<sup>th</sup> Street, and turn right into the parking lot at 5<sup>th</sup> & Lead).

#### **2. NE corner of 5th & Lead**

Take Lead Ave west, just past 5<sup>th</sup> Street, and turn right into the parking lot behind the *Green Café*.
